HSMG 6910 <b>Administrative Internship I</b>	<p>HSMG 691 – Administrative Internship (I) combines didactic and field sessions to introduce the future healthcare leader to the operational management and leadership of public and private components of the health care delivery system. Students will be exposed to the planning, delivery, and financing of health services in organizations including acute care hospitals, long-term care facilities, multi-institutional systems, not-for-profit entities and others. Enrollment is limited to MHA or JD/MHA students only. Physical attendance at all seminars and on-site rotations is mandatory since the experience cannot be made up using shared class notes. Professional attire is required for all class sessions – both in-class seminars and off-site organizational visits. Protective clothing will be provided to the students if and when necessary. Furthermore, students may have contact with individual patients and patient information during this experience and appropriate professional confidentiality is required.</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1.
