HSMG 6920 Administrative Internship II	HSMG 692 – Administrative Internship II is the spring MHA field experience designed to expose the future health care manager to the operations environment. The course begins the administrative practicum in a health care organization. Once placed at a residency site, the students are expected to fulfill a minimum of 8-10 hours per week at the organization. Working with their assigned preceptor, the student will be oriented to the host organization and will identify projects and responsibilities that they will undertake during their administrative residency experience.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Perform as an integral member of a health care leadership team and apply acquired didactic knowledge to operational situations. 2. Generate a practical, in-depth understanding of how one particular health care organization functions, both at the executive and operational levels. 3. Evaluate how health care managers cope with the constraints of time and resources and the need for attention to detail. 4. Review the breadth of factors affecting managerial decision-making and for the political complexity of health care systems. 5. Develop a personal mentoring relationship with a practicing senior manager in a health care organization. 6. Examine and assess the health care industry's values and the expectations of its leaders.
