HSMG 7920 Administrative Residency II	<p>HSMG 792 – Administrative Residency II is the fall MHA field experience designed to further expose the future health care manager to the operations environment. The course is a continuation of the administrative practicum in a health care organization. Following the summer residency course, this course consists of 14 weeks of part-time work during the fall semester. Students are expected to fulfill a minimum of 20 hours per week at the residency site. The student will complete longer-term projects begun during the summer, or begin to assume new responsibilities. Additionally, there will be several on-campus/in-class assignments and a final paper/project due at the end of the semester.</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Perform as an integral member of a health care leadership team and apply acquired didactic knowledge to operational situations. 2. Generate a practical, in-depth understanding of how one particular health care organization functions, both at the executive and operational levels. 3. Evaluate how health care managers cope with the constraints of time and resources and the need for attention to detail. 4. Review the breadth of factors affecting managerial decision-making and for the political complexity of health care systems. 5. Develop a personal mentoring relationship with a practicing senior manager in a health care organization. 6. Examine and assess the health care industry's values and the expectations of its leaders.
